



**ELECTRO-TECHNICAL OFFICERS SECTION A- III/6**

**STANDARD OF COMPETENCE** (In accordance with A III/6. 3-5)

**STANDARDS OR LEVEL OF KNOWLEDGE**

Minimum, ND Marine Electrical

The education and training required by paragraph 2.3 of regulation III/6 shall include training in electronic and electrical workshop skills relevant to the duties of electro-technical officer.

**ON BOARD TRAINING** (In accordance with Section A - III/6. 2-2.3)

Every candidate for certification as electro-technical officer shall follow an approved programme of onboard training which:

- (i) Ensures that, during the required period of seagoing service, the candidate receives systematic practical training and experience in the tasks, duties and responsibilities of an electro-technical officer;
- (ii) Is closely supervised and monitored by qualified and certificated officers aboard the ships in which the approved seagoing service is performed; and
- (i) Is adequately documented in a training record book.
