The essay competition is open to only year 1 and year 2 students of Nigerian tertiary institutions. •Participants are required to scan bona fide proof of studentship alongside their essays. Proof should include letters of admission and identity cards of the institution. •Essays should be sent to both wmdessay@nimasa.gov.ng and mail@samuelson.com.ng Essays should be maximum of 1200 words (+ or – 10%) double spaced in MS word and font size 12 Plagiarism will not be accepted.

Essays should end with the name, telephone number and email address of the participant Essays that do not follow the guidelines will be disqualified .Only successful participants will be contacted.
