### COVID 19 UPDATE

Coronavirus is impacting lives and livelihoods around the world. The fight to stop the virus spreading further is a global challenge. However, now more than ever it is essential that maritime trade carries on with minimal interruptions. Below is a list of vessels presently reporting Nigeria as their destinations with a previous port call in the last 14 days (the period of the virus incubation) in a highly infected area as ranked by the World Health Organization such as USA, RUSSIA, SPAIN, UK, ITALY, GERMANY, and BRAZIL.

The C4I Intelligence System can detect all vessels en route to Nigeria and present their previous port call location. With this ability, the C4I Operational Center can generate a list of vessels with a high risk of transferring the COVID-19.

This list is dedicated to assist authorities in planning effective ways to decide if the vessels should call into the ports to ensure they are safe to enter port areas for any activity.
